



Hamilton Anglers Club - Trophies and Awards

Rules:

- All club annual trophies and awards will be presented at the club AGM which is traditionally held on the last Monday night of May.
- All club trophies and awards to be removed from the SFC upstairs display cabinet by mid. April and cleaned (as necessary) in preparation for engraving.
- The winners of the following trophies and awards will be determined through a review of data collated during the year from organised club trips, club competition night, member feedback at monthly club meetings, all being recorded in the relevant month's club newsletter, this review will be completed by the April Committee meeting.
 - : Gammin Cup, The Dave Winchcombe Memorial Trophy, HASAC Cup, HASAC Plate, Winter Trip Trophy, Summer Trip Trophy, Junior Anglers Trophy, Saltwater Fly Fishing Trophy.
- The winner of the following trophies and awards will be decided by the committee at the April meeting.
 - : Best 'Contribution to the Club' Trophy, Orange Blaster Award.
- The Literary Award winner will be determined by the club editor (by the end of April).
- The Photo Competition winner will be determined by an independent professional photographer (by the end of April).

• **Gammin Cup -**

Awarded originally to the angler with the biggest recorded fish as per the monthly club meetings. This fish must have been weight verified and photographed. The Gammin Cup gets its name from Dick Gammin who owned a sports store in central Hamilton. He donated the trophy in 1957 to be handed out to the angler who had caught the biggest fish in the Waikato region on any legal method. The winner for the first two years was R J Brinkworth with fish over 10lb.



From now on (2018) the Gammin Cup will be awarded to the heaviest recorded Trout species in the Auckland/Waikato Fish and Game Area - Awarded Annually.

• **The Dave Winchcombe Memorial Trophy -**

Dave Winchcombe was a long serving Club member, joining the Club in late 2002 and participating in fly tying classes, club trips, and lake outings until his passing in April 2018. Dave was a member of Taltac since 2012, and spent many hours outside of Club events happily fishing on the Tongariro. Dave was a character who portrayed the image of a "typical" fisherman, he caught many trophy sized fish in his time, hence the Club deciding to create a new Trophy in his memory.

A new trophy for the heaviest recorded Trout species caught on legal means anywhere in New Zealand, except Auckland/Waikato Fish and Game Area.
This fish must have been weight verified and photographed.
